In 2008 CINAHL changed providers, once available through OVID, the database is now featured by EBSCO with a new and improved search layout. This one hour introductory session provided by the Health Sciences Library will enhance and refine your search strategies through lecture, demonstration and hands-on experience searching CINAHL.
