## Program Description

This session will address PubMed - basic and advanced searching, and the use of MeSH. MeSH is the U.S. National Library of Medicine's controlled vocabulary used for indexing articles for MEDLINE/PubMed. MeSH terminology provides a consistent way to retrieve information that may use different terminology for the same concepts.

- Develop and execute efficient searches.
- Integrate MeSH and keyword terms into search.
- Employ built-in limiters to easily refine searches.
- Find full-text articles.
