"Muscling-in" on Type I Diabetes

While complications of Type 1 Diabetes (T1D) are well recognized and studied, there is little known about the impact of T1D on human skeletal muscle, despite its importance to our physical and metabolic well-being (including insulin sensitivity). This presentation will discuss the impact of T1D on skeletal muscle health, in relation to our most recent findings in young adults (18-30 years old) with T1D. Our studies investigating the pathways leading to this myopathic condition will also be highlighted, with a particular focus on therapeutic strategies, which could help alleviate diabetic myopathy and reduce the overall burden of the disease.
