Common law provides that once a person becomes a Director (as in the case of a member of the Northern Ontario School of Medicine's ("NOSM") Board of Directors), that person is, at law, "no one's nominee". That is, the Directors are expected to act in the interests of NOSM, and not in one's own interest or the interest of any other organization. In other words, a Director owes a duty of loyalty to the organization on whose Board he or she serves. This duty must not conflict with personal and professional interest.

In order to satisfy the requirements of accountability and transparency, the following information is required of each Director and committee member of the Board.

- 1. Are you a director or an employee of the Laurentian or Lakehead University? Yes No
- 2. Is your spouse or other family member a director or employee of either University? Yes No
- 3. Are you an employee, faculty member or learner of NOSM? Yes No
- 4. Is your spouse or other family member an employee, faculty member or learner of NOSM? Yes No
- 5. Names of organizations, companies, vendors, contractors, etc. in which you have an interest, directly or indirectly, should NOSM consider a contract or transaction:
