Position Overview:

As an Occupational Therapist with the Dryden Regional Health Centre you will have many opportunities to challenge yourself through applying a broad range of skills to your work with patients/clients. This full time position is for one year, guaranteed 0.6 after that time.

This position entails working in a variety of different settings – home care adult caseload, inpatients and outpatients as required. In home care you will be performing clinical assessments and appropriate interventions in the adult population in their homes. The inpatient unit involves ongoing rehab treatment, home visits, assisting with discharge planning and equipment needs upon discharge. Outpatients cover splinting for hands, wound off loading, or bracing as needed.

You will get an opportunity to use your skills to complete ADP applications for mobility devices, wheelchair prescription, home safety assessments, bathroom safety assessments, bathroom equipment recommendations, falls prevention teaching, kitchen assessments, splinting as needed, cognitive assessments and recommendations for managing changes in cognition, patient and family/care giver education.

Pre-Requisites:

- Bachelors or Master's Degree in Occupational Therapy
- Registration, or eligibility for Registration with the College of Occupational Therapists of Ontario
- Preference given to applicants who are Registered Assistive Devices Program (ADP) Authorizers in the Ambulation Aids, Wheelchair and Positioning Devices/Seating categories.
- Must possess a valid driver's license and vehicle
- Demonstrated ability to apply theoretical knowledge in problem solving and troubleshooting
- Ability to communicate clearly, teach, problem solve and organize
- Flexibility and willingness to work as part of team
- Effective organizational and written skills
- Proficient computer skills
- Able to work and manage a case load independently and with other multi-disciplinary team members
