



ROGER STRASSER NHRC STUDENT TRAVEL AWARD GUIDELINES

In honor of the Northern Ontario School of Medicine's (NOSM's) Founding Dean, Dr. Roger Strasser, an award was created to provide travel funding for one NOSM affiliated student (graduate, undergraduate or resident in good academic standing) per year to present research (oral or poster presentation) at the annual Northern Health Research Conference (NHRC).

Guidelines and Criteria:

- The applicant must be the first author on an approved abstract, and appropriate ethics approval must be in place to qualify for funding.
- The abstract being presented must demonstrate that the research is complete or in progress, with at least preliminary findings.
- Preference will be given to students
 - who have not previously received this award
 - who are presenting research with a social accountability or rural/remote health theme
 - who demonstrate financial need to support travel costs to and from the conference
- A pdf copy of the completed application form and a copy of the approved NHRC Abstract must be submitted by the advertised deadline.
- A maximum of \$1,000 is available to assist with the cost of attending and presenting at the meeting, including travel, accommodation, meals, and registration.
- Once awarded, the claim must be submitted within 6 weeks after the NHRC using the NOSM travel claim form and following the NOSM Travel Policy. You will be required to attend and present at the conference. A substitute will not be permitted.

Application Deadline:

The Research Office will be accepting applications for this award up to May 1, 2020.
