COVID-19: COVID-19 and OB/GYN Care in the North

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DESCRIPTION:

Impact of COVID-19 on pregnancy, women's health and gynecologically related conditions continues to evolve. Although COVID-19 pregnancy related data largely reassuring, available evidence is limited. Questions now arise on the pregnant worker risk as communities move from staying home to work return. As routine women's health care places patients and practitioners at risk of contracting COVID-19, routine cervical screening has been halted with treatment options limited for gynecological care of more serious conditions. Despite lower rates of COVID-19 in the North, geographical distance and other factors provide unique challenges in our provision of women's health care.
