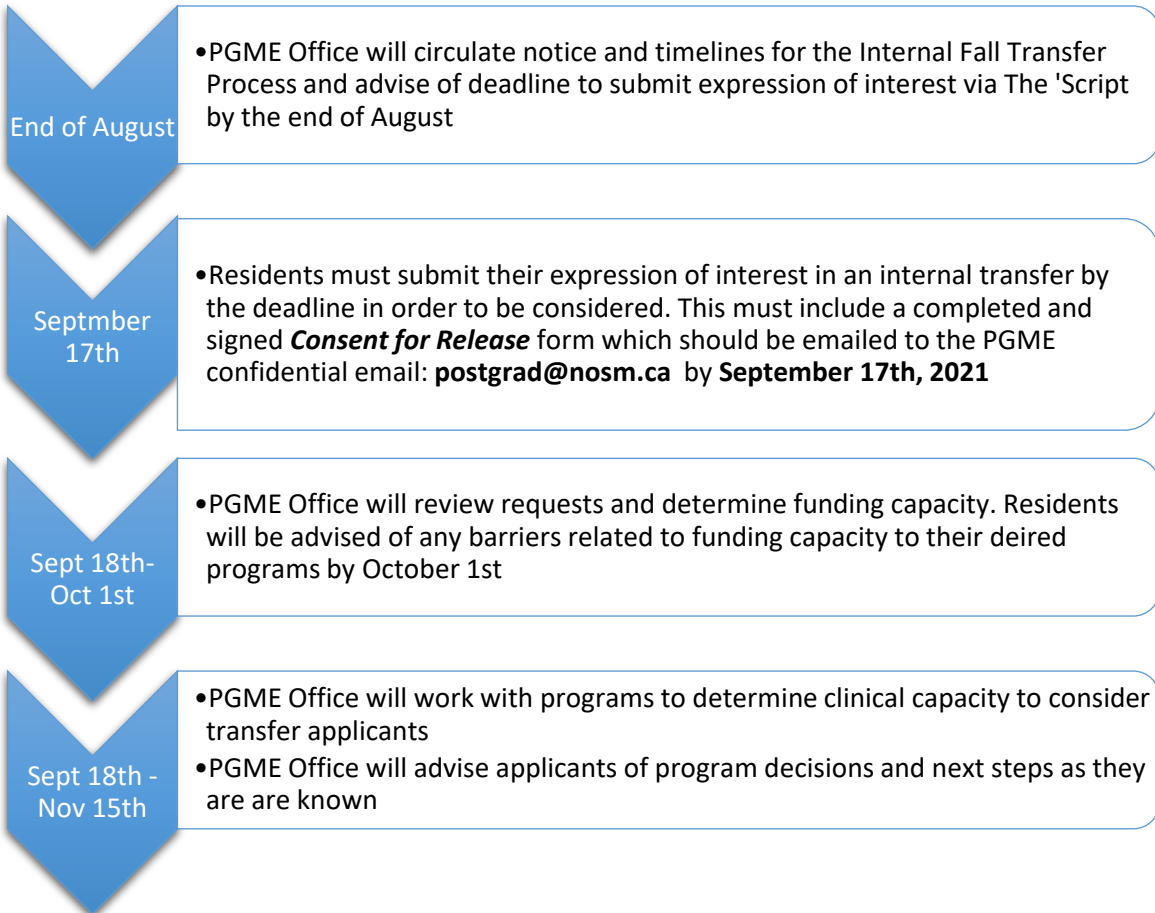


# NOSM PGME Fall Internal Transfer Process- Information for Residents

## **Quick tips for residents:**

- Ensure you have reviewed the [NOSM Transfer of Residency Programs Policy](#) and understand the documentation preparation requirements, should a program decide to review applications. Important to note that while not required as part of your document package, some programs may request letters of reference or additional documentation.
- Advise the PGME Office of your interest in pursuing an internal transfer as soon as possible to ensure there is adequate time to arrange a meeting with the Associate Dean of PGME & HS. The meeting is optional but recommended.
- Ensure the PGME Office remains your only point of contact related to your request for transfer and avoid approaching your desired program directly.

## Important note:

The transfer process itself has no pre-determined timelines and is highly dependent upon capacity within our programs to review and consider applicants. Transfers take an average of 3 months to complete and funding and clinical capacity are not static and change due to a variety of factors. Transfers are not guaranteed and opportunities for transfer are usually quite limited.
