

An innovative 2.5 hour professional development session facilitated via WebEx with NODIP preceptors and dietetic interns in Sault Ste. Marie and District. During the session, interns and preceptors learned with and from each other.



Joint Session Demographics

Interns

- 100% completed the pre-survey
- 100% completed the post survey



Preceptors

- 22% completed the pre-survey
- 33% completed the post survey



Interns...

- Saw feedback as a 2-way conversation
- Were more open to feedback
- Planned to implement feedback
- Planned to increase emotional awareness

Preceptors...

- Saw feedback as a 2-way conversation
- Planned to use a feedback framework

Joint Sessions Enhance Feedback
