The reference letter should be an assessment of the applicant's attributes and include discussion of the following characteristics: leadership, motivation, knowledge, previous scholarly work, and independence. Applicants are responsible for contacting their referees and asking them to email their letters of reference to graduatestudies@nosm.ca by the application deadline.

Proof of MD Degree or Equivalency <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The applicant is responsible for requesting their medical transcripts and having them emailed to graduatestudies@nosm.ca by the application deadline. The applicant must acknowledge that proof of MD Degree or Equivalency must be received by the application deadline. If the applicant completed their MD outside of Canada and the US, MD Degree and transcripts must be assessed and verified by WES or ECFMG/EPIC.
