Population and demographics	Kapuskasing is the largest community located directly on Highway 11 between Thunder Bay and Temiskaming Shores. With a population of just over 8,100 residents, Kapuskasing is surrounded by many small communities, such as Opasatika, Val Rita- Harty, Moonbeam, Fauquier-Strickland and Smooth Rock Falls, and acts as the centre of services to a total population base of approximately 15,000. Our bilingual town offers its residents a healthy lifestyle full of recreation and cultural possibilities.
