Hospital description / services	Manitoulin Health Centre (mhc.on.ca) The Manitoulin Health Centre is one organization with two sites located in Little Current and Mindemoya, Ontario. Manitoulin Health Centre has acute inpatient medical beds at both sites. There are 16 beds located at the Little Current site and 13 beds at the Mindemoya site.
Primary Care model / clinic setup / allied health support	The Central Manitoulin Family Health Team (MCFHT). is an RNP/PA1 salaried model. A combination of clinical and emergency services make this an interesting opportunity for a rewarding practice experience. This is a very cooperative team, working in an integrated model. The MCFHT offers the services of Nurse Practitioners, Registered Nurses, Health Promotion, Dietetic, Pharmacy, Physiotherapy, Social Work, Traditional Healing and Psychiatry. In addition, Monday-Friday daily joint rounds provide an interactive opportunity to discuss care planning for hospital in-patients, emergency and office patients with an interdisciplinary team.
Other clinical venues and services	The team also provides clinic to First Nation communities.
