Hospital description / services	McCausland Hospital located in Terrace Bay is a fully accredited hospital with 10 acute beds, 13 chronic and attached is Wilkes Terrace Long Term Care with 22 beds. There is X-ray, Ultrasound, Laboratory, Chemotherapy, Physiotherapy, Telehealth on site. 24 Hour on-call Hospital emergency coverage is shared among the 4 physicians with typical low acuity and numbers.







Primary Care model / clinic setup / allied health support	One clinic in each community, each employing 2 full time physicians and the shared services of nurse practitioner, dietician, social/mental health worker and diabetes nurse. There is reception and billing staff at each location.

	bonuses. There are additional benefits for full time – 37 days holidays and eligibility for
