The Thunder Bay Hand & Upper Limb Clinic is a multi-disciplinary private facility treating all hands, elbow, shoulder injuries throughout a region of over 250,000 people. Our clients are 80% post-operative, usually more complex conditions requiring specialized skills including: wound care, splinting, manual therapy techniques, and sensory-motor assessment. Close communication with surgeons, of which we have a group of 5 who operate exclusively on the upper limb, is required.

We will help you become an incredibly important member of the team, two Occupational Therapist's (including a Certified Hand Therapist), two Physiotherapist's, and surgeons.
