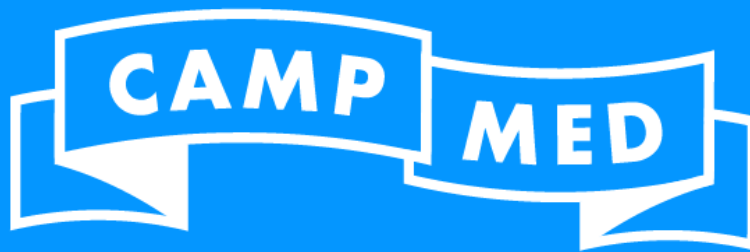

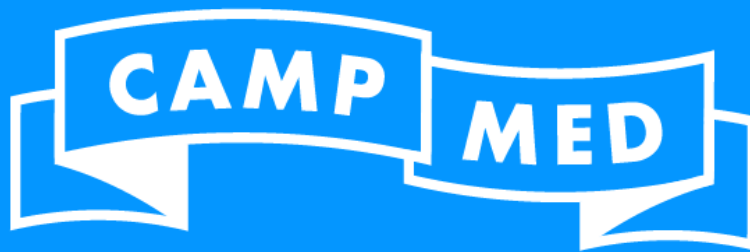

**Cultural:** At CampMed, participants will learn about Francophone and Indigenous health and culture in ways that will broaden their understanding of the health needs or Northern Ontario. In simple terms they learn what it means to be a socially accountable health professional. These cultural competencies are woven throughout the week-long curriculum.



**Clinical Skills:** CampMed offers participants a unique opportunity to get hands-on experience by learning medical and health sciences clinical skills, such as casting, doing IV injections, etc.
