

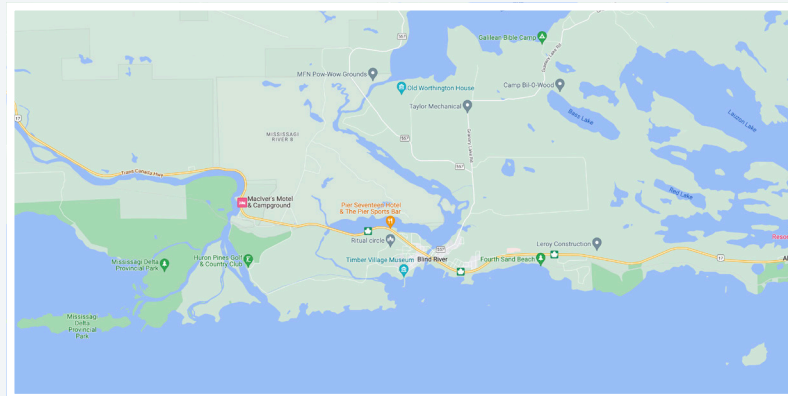

HOSPITAL DESCRIPTION / SERVICES

North Shore Health Network (nshn.care)

The North Shore Health Network (NSHN) is a multi-site organization serving communities from Echo Bay, ON to Spanish, ON. – including St. Joseph's Island.

NSHN sites are located in Blind River, ON, Thessalon, ON, and Richards Landing, ON.

PRIMARY CARE MODEL / CLINIC SETUP / ALLIED HEALTH SUPPORT

Huron Shores Family Health Team is co-located with a Family Health Organization providing primary healthcare services to a catchment area of approximately 6,000 residents. Our interdisciplinary team consists of a nurse practitioner, registered nurses, pharmacists, a diabetes education nurse, chiropodists, and a dietitian. We also offer several programs to the community, such as a Smoking Cessation Program and Chronic Pain Self-Management Program. Located adjacent to the NSHN, physicians at HSFHT provide on-call coverage in the 24-hour Emergency Department and provide medical care to Acute Care in-patients and Long Term Care residents.

OTHER CLINICAL VENUES AND SERVICES

In addition to clinical, Emergency Department, Acute Care, and Long Term Care coverage, physicians at HSFHT actively participate in interprofessional meetings, and can be members of varying committees.

SUPPORTS AND EXPECTATIONS FOR LOCUMS OR LEARNERS COMING TO THE COMMUNITY

TEACHING

This site accepts learners and residents in Family Medicine.
