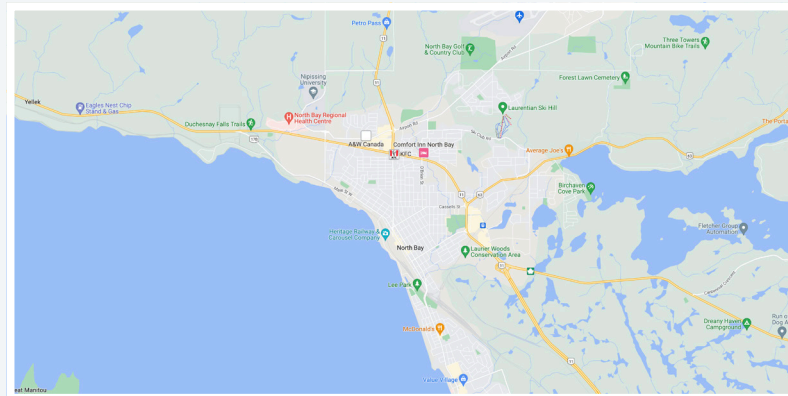

North Bay is located 3.5 hours north of Toronto, just down the four-lane highway from the Muskokas, and 3.5 hours west of Ottawa. Short 1 hour daily flights are available in and out of the city. With a population of 54,000 and a catchment area of 180,000, it is a safe and welcoming community that offers a healthy and balanced environment for working, living and raising a family. CLINICAL SERVICES

CATCHMENT AREA AND DEMOGRAPHICS

NBRHC serves the Nipissing District with a catchment of over 180,000 people. The hospital's Regional Mental Health Services provide inpatient beds in North Bay and Sudbury and outpatient and outreach services throughout the region—from Hudson Bay to Muskoka from Sault Ste. Marie to the Quebec border.

HOSPITAL DESCRIPTION / SERVICES

North Bay Regional Health Centre (NBRHC) is a state-of-the-art regional healthcare centre that has a catchment area of 180,000 with strong inpatient and out-patient specialist support. Circa 2011, this newly built 419 bed facility has three primary roles: providing acute care services to North Bay and its surrounding communities, functioning as the district referral center providing specialist services for smaller communities in the area, and it's the specialized mental health service provider serving all of northeast Ontario.

NBRHC has over 2100 staff, 160 core physicians with acute privileges and 300 volunteers supporting care.

Most North Bay Family Physicians are members of the NBRHC Department of General & Family Practice. These physicians practice comprehensive family medicine that includes hospital inpatient care. Members provide hospital inpatient care to their rostered patients and share in the care of admitted orphan patients. TEACHING

Home Based Residency Spots

North Bay has the following spots for CaRMS:

- 1 resident spot per year for Psychiatry
- 4 resident spots per year for Family Medicine

North Bay is also a site for the NOSM University 3rd year Comprehensive Community Clerks (CCCs) which complete a 7 month clerkship from September to March each year. North Bay has 8 CCC spots.

Visiting Medical Learner Rotations

Medical learner rotations availability in North Bay include Anesthesia, Emergency Medicine, Family Medicine, Hospitalist, General Internal Medicine, Dermatology, General Surgery, ENT, Urology, Orthopedic Surgery, Obstetrics & Gynecology, Pediatrics, Psychiatry (various subspecialties), Palliative Care, Pathology, Radiology, and Ophthalmology.
