



AMENITIES

The Municipality of Machin is made up of 3 communities all located on the beautiful Eagle Lake. Eagle River, Minnitaki and Vermilion Bay are all located in the heart of Sunset Country on the TransCanada Highway.

Eagle Lake is home to walleye, northern pike, trophy musky, smallmouth bass, lake trout and whitefish. Eagle Lake is quite large - its 90 miles long and covers over 65,000 acres. The lake has over 490 islands with many channels and bays.

Vermilion Bay is a starting off point for many fly-in outposts.

Blue Lake Provincial Park - Welcome to Blue Lake Provincial Park (ontarioparks.com) is minutes away, renowned for its crystal clear waters and long sandy beach, Blue Lake is an outstanding destination for all types of water activities. There are also many public beaches in the area and walking trails.

Vermilion Bay and area is a popular destination for wilderness experiences – fishing, hunting and camping. You will see the most incredible sunsets and northern lights (visitsunsetcountry.com).

In the winter, bring your skates, snowshoes or skis. Quad and snow machine trails can take you for miles into the Canadian wilderness.

The nearest ambulance service at this time is located in Dryden, 45 km away. Vermilion Bay is equipped with a volunteer fire department whose members are trained in first response and attend to persons who call 911 until ambulance arrives. They also attend to accident scenes, fires etc.

Vermilion Bay will have an ambulance base in the near future.

PRIMARY CARE MODEL / CLINIC SETUP / ALLIED HEALTH SUPPORT

We are an interdisciplinary team of health care professionals working collaboratively to provide comprehensive primary health care services to our patients.

The team operation consists of coordinating patient care between the various health professionals providing streamlined care and quality visits.

We use the advance access protocol and as a result the patients are able to get an appointment when they need to be seen.

Full spectrum of practice:

Acute care, chronic care and disease prevention (Diabetes, CHF, CVD, Cancer Screening, Immunization) vestibular assessments, dermascope clinic, lumps and bumps, surgical consults, women's health, counselling, system navigation, laboratory services.

RNPGA model with one physician and one admin staff (Machin Medical Clinic. We also have a Family Health Team (Points North Family Health Team) which includes administrative staff, Executive Director, RN, NP and Social Worker
