Currently the hospital is designated as having 25 acute, 1 hospice suite, 8 continuing care and 37 long-term care beds.

A 33-bed hospital situated in the town of Cochrane, Lady Minto Hospital services surrounding communities with a variety of health care such as physiotherapy, laboratory, diagnostic imaging, electrocardiogram, clinical nutrition, Holter Monitoring, diabetes program, chemotherapy, general surgery and OTN. They maintain a 24-hour a day, 7 days a week emergency department. Their closest referral hospital is Timmins & District Hospital which is about one hour away.

The Cochrane Family Health Team located next to the Lady Minto Hospital is comprised of multi-disciplinary health professionals who provide primary care to the people of Cochrane and surrounding areas. This team includes a family physician, a nurse practitioner, nurses and a social worker.


