

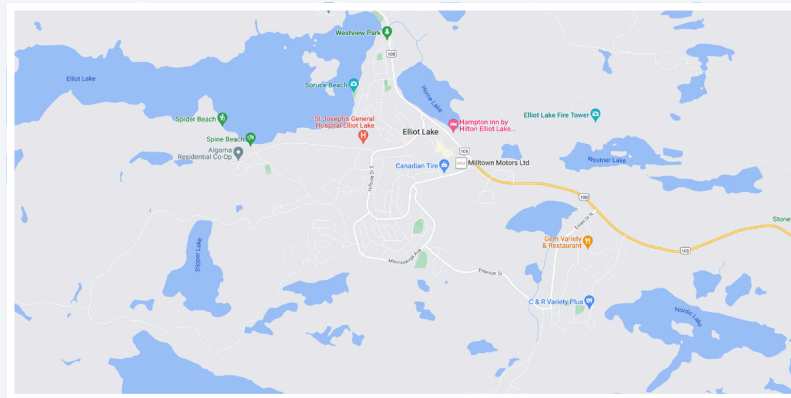

COMMUNITY DESCRIPTION

POPULATION AND DEMOGRAPHICS

Elliot Lake, ON has a population of 10,741 people. The largest population of Elliot Lake, ON is the age group between 65 and 69 years old, 51.74% of the population are in the working age group between 15 to 64 years old, while 20.05% make up the younger population, which will be a part of labour force in less than 2 decades.

AMENITIES

The community is serviced by Canada's five major banks and a credit union. There are accounting firms, insurance agencies, law firms and a legal aid office serving the community.

There are hundreds of businesses including national chain stores such as Canadian Tire, Shopper's Drug Mart, Rexall Drugs, Rona, FoodLand, No Frills, Hart Store and The Source to name a few.

Elliot Lake has three major automobile dealerships, Algoma Chrysler, North Shore Ford and Milltown Motors (featuring GM and Chevrolet products). Local businesses offer furniture, pet supplies, a delicatessen, flower and gift shops, clothing stores, hardware and many others.

There are approximately seventy businesses offering personal service that include such things as hair styling, spa services, upholstery, auto repairs, appliance maintenance.



There are some small manufacturing businesses as well as a number of contractors offering a variety of carpentry, electrical, masonry, decorating, plumbing and general construction services.

For your pet's medical needs, the city has veterinary clinics and businesses that provide boarding and grooming for pets.

TRAVEL OPTIONS

You can find the City of Elliot Lake in Algoma District within Northern Ontario, and in between the cities of Sault Ste. Marie and Sudbury. Elliot Lake sits just north of Lake Huron, with easy access by going north on Ontario Highway 108, just 25 km off the Trans-Canada Highway.

OTHER CLINICAL VENUES AND SERVICES

St. Joseph's Manor

St. Joseph's Manor's strives to provide a home like environment for individuals whose daily care requirements are too extensive to be met in other care environments. We support residents to be as active and engaged in our community to the best of their abilities. There are two floors, home to 32 residents each. We have two veteran priority beds.

Hillside Park Retirement Residence

Hillside Park Retirement Residence is an assisted-living environment. Situated on ten acres in the heart of Elliot Lake, Hillside Park provides today's seniors a healthy lifestyle choice. Hillside Park provides recreational facilities, planned activities of daily living, care assistance, and much more.

Huron Lodge

Huron Lodge is a small, residential facility that provides a relaxed, friendly atmosphere to older adults. The facility determines the level of care required and eligibility.

The Oaks Acute Care Department

The Oaks is an acute care accredited hospital, treating the whole person, operated by St. Joseph's General Hospital Elliot Lake. It is comprised of two departments: Withdrawal Management Services and Camillus Treatment Programs. Oaks Department services are supported and partially funded

Oaks department Services offer an eclectic treatment model, tailored to individual patient needs. There is a medical director on site, who has been practicing medicine since 1981 and is an expert in the field of addiction treatment and recovery.

Counselling Centre of East Algoma

The Counselling Centre of East Algoma (CCEA) has offered confidential counselling services to individuals, couples, families, and groups throughout the East Algoma catchment area.

Community Mental Health & Addictions Program – HSN East Algoma Site (Elliot Lake)

A community-based program providing free and confidential mental health and addictions services in Elliot Lake and surrounding areas. These services are for individuals, family members and service providers who are looking for support and information for adults with mental health concerns.
