

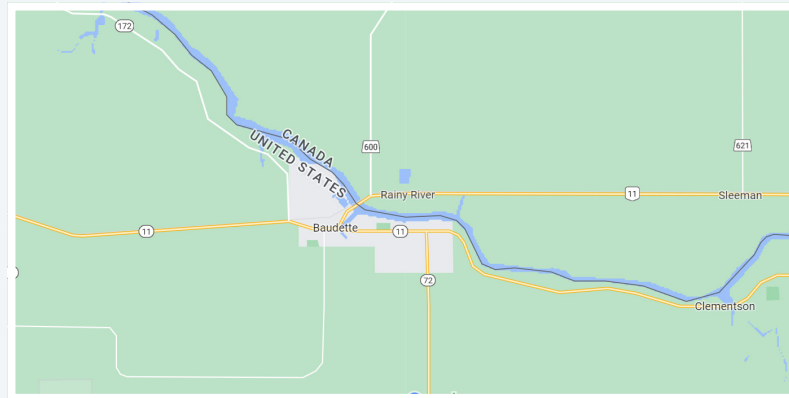

COMMUNITY DESCRIPTION

The Town of Rainy River (Rainy River District) is a great place to raise a family. The warm, friendly people live in a relaxed and satisfying lifestyle with superb natural treasures and exciting outdoor activities, coupled with great entertainment. Ninety km west of Fort Frances, Rainy River is a town of 1100 residents, the area transitions from Canadian Shield into agricultural farmland. The agricultural area of the district runs about 100 km between Lake of the Woods to the west and Rainy Lake to the East and about 35 km between the Rainy River to the south and the Precambrian shield to the north. Production in the agricultural community includes dairy products, cow-calf operations and grain production, prevalent in the town of Rainy River. Rainy River, built on its' namesake river is a busy borderland community with Baudette, MN. It offers affordable housing and full-service health centre with 24/7 ER, long term care and inpatient care.

TRAVEL OPTIONS

Airports

Fort Frances Municipal Airport is located 2.2 nautical miles (4.1km or 2.5 mi) northwest of Fort Frances.

International Falls Airport is located in International Falls, MN, just across a small bridge from Fort Frances, ON, International Falls Airport has several daily Delta flights. It is 45 minutes to Minneapolis St Paul. Car rentals, shuttle and cabs available. Small fee to cross bridge.

Rail

Canadian National Railway is located in the heart of Fort Frances, and runs both east and west through the Rainy River District. This rail line carries products across Canada to and from the shipping ports of Thunder Bay.

King's Highway

Highway 11, is a provincially maintained highway in the province of Ontario. At 1,780.2 kilometres (1,106.2 mi), it is the second longest highway in the province, following Highway 17.

Canada-USA Borders

Fort Frances – International Falls border crossing is the busiest crossing in Minnesota and is in the top 20% of all crossings between the United States and Canada. Although it carries a fair number of trucks it is used mostly by local residents and vacationers. This crossing is applicable to toll fees.

Rainy River – Baudette border crossing is the most westerly border crossing between Ontario and Minnesota, and is the 4th busiest crossing in Minnesota. It is used mainly by vacationers and local autos with little truck traffic. There is no toll fee to cross at this crossing.
