

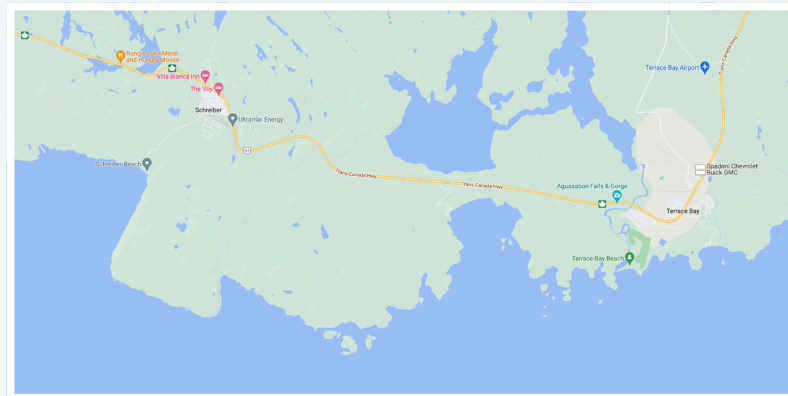

### HOSPITAL DESCRIPTION / SERVICES

McCausland Hospital located in Terrace Bay is a fully accredited hospital with 10 acute beds, 13 chronic and attached is Wilkes Terrace Long Term Care with 22 beds.

There is X-ray, Ultrasound, Laboratory, Chemotherapy, Physiotherapy, Telehealth on site.

24 Hour on-call Hospital emergency coverage is shared among the 4 physicians with typical low acuity and numbers.

### PRIMARY CARE MODEL / CLINIC SETUP / ALLIED HEALTH SUPPORT

One clinic in each community, each employing 2 full time physicians and the shared services of nurse practitioner, dietician, social/mental health worker and diabetes nurse. There is reception and billing staff at each location.

NO OVERHEAD for physicians – with a competitive remuneration provided through RNPGA contract/salary according to quality and scope of practice + On call stipend + MOH bonuses. There are additional benefits for full time – 37 days holidays and eligibility for grants and the earning potential is \$450K per year.

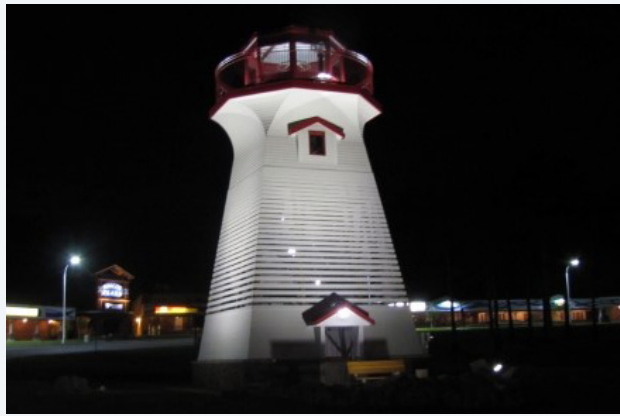
