



Be a SA ambassador at all levels


Influence on policy

# SA in A: Standards

"What is not measured is not given as much importance"

## **General framework**

- "Much work still to be done"
- Needs. Actions. Impact.
- "Based on shared values"
- A learning opportunity
- Framework from leaders (eg. AFMC) welcomed

## Standards

- "A one-standard confirming importance"
- "SA permeating all standards"
- "Meaningful" "Contextual" measurement
- "Must consider the movement"
- "Emphasis on outcomes"

## Evidence: Action Research on SA "We need the proof"

### Metrics

- "Have not still been worked out"
- "Impact takes time"
- Use proxy measures
- Ultimate measure: impact on people's health

#### Research

- "A research frame of reference needed"
- To demonstrate "how SA works"
- Ongoing building of evidence
- An issue of "credibility"

SA and SA in A : keep the momentum

- "SA and SA in A is a movement"
