INDIGEGOGY - Relevance of Indigenous Health Practice, in a Modern Setting – with Craig AbotossawayIn this interactive session, Craig Abotossaway presented a hybrid workshop, melding components of cultural awareness and Indigenous history, with discourse on the relevance of Anishnabe worldview and ancient healing practices. The intent was to help the learner build healthy relationships with First Nations people, offering pathways

to reconciliation, through increased knowledge and understanding.
