

Senate Enabling Motion – Approval of Graduands

As a standing policy, the Provost and/or the Program Associate Dean or Assistant Dean and the Registrar be empowered to approve graduands who do not appear on the graduands list to Senate, but who are found to have completed all the requirements for their undergraduate/graduate degrees and diplomas prior to the next meeting of Senate. The candidates name(s) must be forwarded directly to the NOSM University Registrar prior to the set deadline. These late graduands will be placed on list to Senate as an item of information at the next scheduled meeting by the Registrar.

The enabling motion has been a common practice for many years for the NOSM Academic Council as well as the NOSM University Senate, however included in each motion. This one motion will allow this to be a standard policy that empowers the appropriate Associate Dean, Assistant Dean or Provost and Registrar to approve late additions to the graduands' list who had not appeared on the convocation list. This will also allow any late candidates to join the convocation ceremonies (if applicable). The Registrar sets that deadline and can be found under Important Dates – Academic Calendar.
