The Chair opened the meeting with a Land Acknowledgement Message:

NOSM University respectfully acknowledges that the entirety of the University's wider campus across Northern Ontario is situated on the homelands of First Nations and Métis Peoples. The University's buildings in Thunder Bay and Sudbury are located on the territory of the Anishinabek Nation, specifically the homelands of Fort William First Nation, Atikameksheng Anishnawbek, and Wahnapitae First Nations.

We recognize the deep and ongoing relationships Indigenous Peoples have with this land, and we honour their histories, cultures, and contributions & as a university, we remain committed to supporting reconciliation through education, collaboration, and respect.

Let us carry this awareness into our discussions and decisions today and strive to be accountable partners in advancing health equity and supporting Indigenous communities.
