

- Greater Sudbury is a world class mining centre. The local mining companies employ approximately 6,000 people and support a 300-company mining supply and service sector cluster that employs a further 14,000 people. The city is also a regional centre for financial and business services, tourism, health care and research, education, and government for Northeastern Ontario.

Greater Sudbury is considered the largest urban centre for Northeastern Ontario and has the [Greater Sudbury Airport](#) within the community. Greater Sudbury is also accessible via Hwy 69, Hwy 17, and Hwy 144. Greater Sudbury is a four-hour drive from Toronto via Hwy 400/Hwy 69, and there are daily flights from Toronto to Greater Sudbury, making it a very easy commute to and from Ontario's largest urban centre.
