Description

Working within the context of a multidisciplinary team, the Registered Dietitian (RD) will be completing individual nutrition assessments, developing nutrition care plans and providing nutrition counselling for the management of conditions commonly seen in primary care including diabetes, obesity, cardiovascular disease, gastrointestinal disorders, disordered eating, bariatric care and other medical needs. This role requires the ability to work effectively with patients, providers and other health professional in a fast-paced, dynamic team environment. The Huron Shores Family Health Team (HSFHT) Dietitian will participate in program development, health promotion and will work collaboratively with external partners. Huron Shores Family Health Team is seeking a highly motivated, self-directed individual with strong interpersonal skills to join our multi-disciplinary team.

Duties

- Provide medical nutrition therapy for chronic disease management and prevention to adults and children
- Identify nutrition problems, assess nutritional status of patients and develop care plans
- Conduct comprehensive nutrition assessments and ensure ongoing nutritional care by maintaining complete and accurate client records, assessment notes and required correspondence, and by monitoring client progress on a regular basis
- Communicates nutrition care plans and debriefs with primary care team members as needed
- Provide evidence-based nutrition counselling and education to patients and families in both individual and group settings
- Facilitate/co-facilitate groups with other staff of the HSFHT
- Adhere to all privacy, confidentiality, and health and safety regulations
- Other duties as assigned.
